(i)	Brief introduction of the university	Vivekananda Global University, Jaipur is a private university under the Rajasthan State (Act No.11 of 2012) as was notified by the government of Rajasthan vide Gazette notification No.F.2(17) vidhi/2/2012 dated 2 nd May, 2012 and Gazette Notification No.F.2(33) Vidhi/2/2013 dated 16.09.2013 sponsored by Bagaria Education Trust. The University aims to start new degrees and diploma programs. The University has made efforts to provide impetus to students for learning and to enhance their employability skills. Labs are designed keeping in mind the recent scenario and industrial requirements.

(iii)	Brief description of the University and its faculties/course	The Vivekananda Global University, Jaipur, catering to the modern needs of education combined with the traditional Indian values, is a private university under the state government act. The focus of the university is on entrepreneurship development and innovation. The various faculties instituted in the University are; 1. Faculty of Engineering and Technology for Diploma in Engineering, B.Tech, M.Tech, and Doctoral Programs. 2. Faculty of Basic and Applied Sciences for B.Sc, M.Sc and Doctoral Programs 3. Faculty of International Trade and Commerce for B.Com Programme. 4. Faculty of Management Studies for BBA, MBA and Doctoral Programmes.

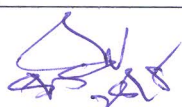

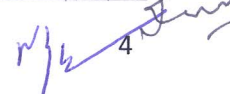

The constructed area is 21565 Sq. Mt., Classroom area is 2531 Sq. Mt. and Labs area is 4641 Sq. Mt. Library: The library has an area of 1054.3 Sq. Mt. and the total volumes of books available are 9234 and also has a digital library, however needs to add more number of e- journals. Sports and Games Facilities: Facility for in door and outdoor sports like table-tennis, carom, chess, badminton, volleyball, basket ball, hockey, football, cricket, play field for track and field events, yoga & meditation and gymnasium have been created in the campus. Residential accommodation including hostels: There are separate hostels for boys & girls. The rooms are furnished and have facilities, duly supervised by Hostel Wardens. The hostels are Wi-Fi enabled and equipped with generators in order to provide 24 hour's electricity supply and water coolers.

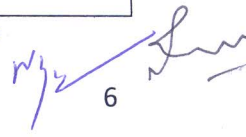

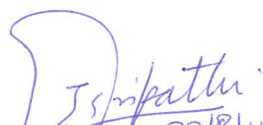
