As you are aware, the Governments of India and the United States of America have launched a joint initiative namely, **Singh–Obama 21st Century Knowledge Initiative**. The main objective of the initiative is to foster partnerships between educational institutions of both the countries in the field of higher education and research. Many schemes are being devised to achieve the objective of the initiative. One such scheme devised was to invite project proposals from institutions recognized under Section 12B of the UGC Act, 1956 and from Institutions of National Importance for financial assistance in the areas of **Energy Studies, Sustainable Development, Climate Change, Environmental Studies, Education and Educational Reform & Community Development and Innovation**. Accordingly, the UGC invited proposals from institutions in December, 2012 with the last date being set for receipt of proposals as 20th January, 2013. However, in order to invite more competitive proposals from institutions, the UGC has extended the time limit for submission of proposals to **15th March, 2013**.
