The UGC Expert Committee visited the Private University on 14-15th November, 2009. The report of the Expert Committee (**Appendix (P.190-200)**) was placed before the Commission at its 467th meeting held on 16th January, 2010 (Item No. 5.02). The Commission considered and approved the report of the Expert Committee and decided that the deficiencies pointed out by the Committee may be communicated to the Private University with a request to overcome the deficiencies and send a compliance report within six months.

Accordingly, a copy of the Expert Committee Report was sent to the Private University for submission of compliance in respect of the observations/suggestions made by the UGC Expert Committee. The compliance submitted by the University was examined by the Bureau and on some of the issues further compliance and supporting documents were sought from the University.
