UGC has notified the procedure and criteria for declaration of result for NET which is going to be held on 30th December, 2012. The candidates will be required to obtain minimum marks in each paper separately, i.e., 40%, 40% & 50% for general category; 35%, 35% & 45% for OBC category and 35%, 35% and 40% for SC/ST/PWD candidates in Paper I, II & III respectively. Amongst those candidates who have obtained minimum marks, a merit list will be prepared subject-wise and category-wise using the aggregate marks of all the three papers secured by such candidates. Top 15% candidates (for each subject and category), from this merit list, will be declared NET qualified for eligibility for lectureship only. A separate merit list for the award of JRF will be prepared from amongst the NET qualified candidates figuring in the merit list.

About 7.8 Lakh candidates have registered for the said examination which will be conducted in 78 subjects at 77 centres spread across the country.
