1. BACKGROUND OF THE UNIVERSITY:

Shri Jagdishprasad Jhabarmal Tibrewala University was founded and established as a Self Financed (Private) University by an Act of the legislative Assembly of the Rajasthan vide Act No. F2(5) Vidhi/2/2009 and as per Ordinance No. 7 of 2008 Government of Rajasthan (Dated February 5, 2009) (Rajasthan Gazette Extraordinary). A Unit of Shri Rajasthani Seva Sangh – A public Charitable Trust Registered under Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860, Bombay Registration Act No. 44 of 1960 and Bombay Public Trust Act 1950 (Registration No. F- 774, dated 25-06- 1960).

Vision of The University: The University is a great warehouse of learning , a great bureau of standards, a great workshop of knowledge, a great laboratory for the training as well of men of thought as of men of action. The University is thus the instrument of the state for the construction of the knowledge, for the discovery of knowledge, for the distribution of knowledge and above all for the creation of the knowledge makers.

Mission of the University: The mission of **Shri Jagdishprasad Jhabarmal Tibrewala University** is "Learning to care: Education for the 21st Century". The Mission of the University is to provide students with an opportunity to learn and interact with top most experts in their fields of expertise. To provide a value based professional education with industry integrated mode. To expertise the students in production and marketing skills for quality control.

Objectives of the University:

As Society becomes more and more complex, **Shri Jagdishprasad Jhabarmal Tibrewala University** is pressed to assume social obligations- to train for employment, to solve social problems, to help set ethical directions for society. Prior to the actual assessment of **Shri Jagdishprasad Jhabarmal Tibrewala University**, Vidyanagari, Village- Chudela, District- Jhunjhunu (Rajasthan), Prof. A.S. Brar , Chairman and Dr. (Mrs.) Urmila Devi, Member Secretary of the Expert Committee briefed all the members about the purpose of the visit. Members of the expert committee

were asked to carry out the inspection in the light of the UGC (Establishment and maintenance of Standards in Private Universities) Regulations, 2003.

The members of the Expert Committee were received by the Chancellor, Acting Vice – Chancellor (Dr. R.J. Bhongle), Members of the Board of Management (Er. Vinod D. Tibrewala et al), Registrar (Mr. Lokesh S. Saxena), Director (Dr. S. K. Yadav), Finance Officer (Mr. Rajj Prashenna Kumaor D.), Controller of Examinations & Deans of the Faculties.

After a brief introduction of expert members, the Director (Academics and Research) of the University made a presentation on the background of the University, activities and programmes (proposed and offered) by the University. The vision and objectives of the University were shared with the members of the Expert Committee. After the presentation a number of queries were raised by the Expert Committee. The queries and clarifications were satisfactorily addressed by the Director and other officers. Thereafter, the Expert Committee visited all the available facilities and supporting facilities like Central Library, Hostel, Gym, Sports facilities, Auditorium, Health Centre, Green House, Sport Complex, Workshops etc. The Committee also held a detailed discussion with the students, staff (Teaching and Non- Teaching), members of the Board of Management and Governing body. 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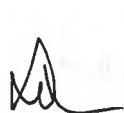
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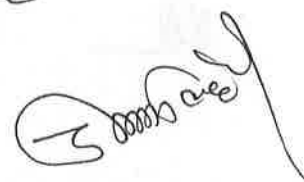

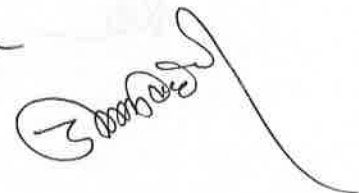

➤ **OBSERVATIONS OF THE COMMITTEE:**

- (a) **Shri Jagdishprasad Jhabarmal Tibrewala University** is established by Shri Rajasthani Seva Sangh, a Public Charitable Trust by an Act of Rajasthan Legislative Assembly (Notification no.: Act (5) vidhi/2/2009, dated: February 5, 2009) . The University is located near a village named chudela, 20 Km. away from Jhunjhunu on Jhunjhunu - Churu Highway.
- (b) **The focus of the University is to promote research and development in the field of Management, Engineering, Information Technology and Applied Sciences to impart industry integrated Higher Education.**
- (c) **Shri Jagdishprasad Jhabarmal Tibrewala University** is being developed around the research driven model – its research agenda includes, preparing an intensive as well as extensive data base of Arawali region and to work more and more research and development in different fields including conservation of heritage.
- (d) The University embodies five faculties viz. Information Technology, Management Sciences, Engineering and Technology, Basic and Applied Sciences and Languages.
- (e) The University is following curriculum from the Rajasthan Technical University. The University has 52 sanctioned teaching posts. Out of these 25 positions have been filled up for the total enrollment of 162 students in the University.
- (f) The University has built adequate academic area for the existing student's strength.
- (g) A collaborative MoU has been signed with COSIA (Chamber of Small Industry Association) and a Russian University of Health Sciences for Academic Exchange Programme. The University is also trying to collaborate

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with some of the leading professional institutions to enhance skill - set and ensure the overall development of the students.

- (h) The University is quite serious about health care of faculty and students. As a result the University has built up **Yoga and Meditation Centre, Gym and Huge Sports Ground** for indoor and outdoor games.
- (i) The University has not developed well equipped Science and Engineering Laboratories/ Workshops etc.
- (j) Physical infrastructure of the University in terms of constructed area, class rooms, laboratories, warehouses, hostels, auditorium etc. are available.
- (k) On meeting with the officers of the University and the teachers of the University, Expert Committee members came to know that 90% of the teachers do not fulfil eligibility criteria of UGC/AICTE. Most of the teachers are having B.Tech Degrees.
- (l) Enrolment in various courses is very small it may be 4-5 minimum to 20 maximum.
- (m) Infrastructure of the laboratories is not sufficient to impart high quality of practical training for the students.
- (n) Most of the teachers mentioned on role are not actual regular teachers, they are mostly settled outside the university campus.
- (o) The University has admitted 162 students in first two years, it is very unlikely university will be able to sustain in the future.
- (p) It is doubtful that the faculty published 88 papers.
- (q) On meeting with the teachers it was pointed out that they are not getting the UGC pay scales.

➤ RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE COMMITTEE:

1. In view of the above facts and observations, discussions with students, staff members (teaching and non- teaching), and members of the Board of Management of the University the Expert Committee is of the opinion that Shri Jagdishprasad Jhabarmal Tibrewala University (A private University), Vidyanagari, Village -Chudela, District – Jhunjhunu, Established by an Act






of State Legislative of Rajasthan, is not fulfilling the norms/regulations of the UGC/AICTE.

2. The Expert Committee suggests that the reassessment of the University be undertaken by the UGC after passing out three batches of their Undergraduate courses (B.Tech.) or five years w.e.f. the current year. (Establishment and Maintenance of Standards in Private Universities) Regulations, 2003.
3. The University is likely to start a Ph.D programme in all disciplines without competent faculty and proper infrastructure i.e. labs and computational facilities. The Expert Committee feels that at this stage the University should not be permitted to start Ph.D. Programme.

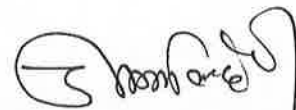
