The interested students shall also have to apply online on www.stipendiumhungaricum.hu. **Last date for online application is 30th April, 2015**. After submitting the application online, the candidates must send a hard copy of the printed out application along with the relevant documents to the University Grants Commission on the address, **The Section Officer, International Cooperation Section, Room No. 508, University Grants Commission, Bahadur Shah Zafar Marg, New Delhi – 110002**. The last date for submission of the hard copy at the UGC office is **5th May, 2015**.

As per the provisions mentioned in the Educational Exchange Programme Agreement signed between the Ministry of Human Capacities of Hungary and the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, the Hungarian Government has offered scholarships for Indian students to pursue undergraduate, postgraduate and doctoral studies in Hungary.

These Scholarships will primarily be in the fields of Natural and Life Sciences, Information Technology, Economics, Business Management and Engineering

Candidates applying for all the above mentioned scholarships programmes shall have an appropriate knowledge of English Language on a certain level that is defined by the host Institution.

Financial Provisions:

The Hungarian party shall provide to the Indian Scholarships holders:

- (a) Tuition free course
- (b) Dormitory places may be offered as per capacity of the host institutions
- (c) Medical Insurance
- (d) Monthly allowance (HUF 40460 stipend per month in case of BA/B.Sc/MA/M.Sc and HUF 1,00,000/- stipend per month for PhD. Students)

NOTE: The Indian side shall borne the cost of International travel for the Indian Students visiting Hungary.
