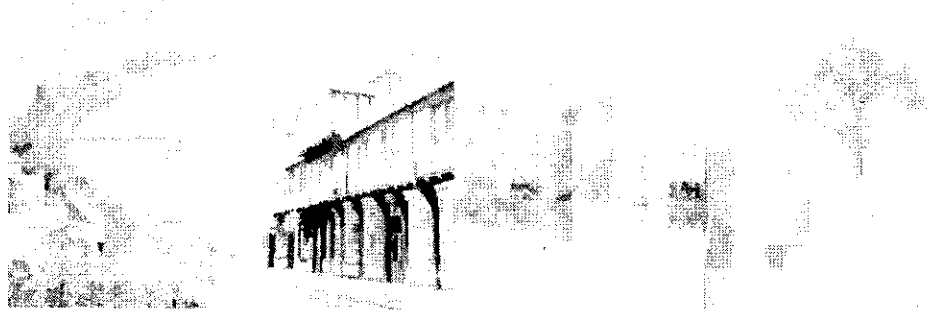

Erasmus Mundus Visiting Scholarships

MUNDUS MAPP

The Erasmus Mundus Masters Program in Public Policy (Mundus MAPP) is a two-year-long international Masters course funded by the European Commission, jointly offered by **Central European University (Hungary)**, **Institut Barcelona d'Estudis Internacionals (Spain)**, the **International Institute of Social Studies of Erasmus University Rotterdam (the Netherlands)**, and the **University of York (UK)**.

The Mundus MAPP Consortium is hosting outstanding third-country scholars who are interested in contributing to the study program and strengthening academic partnerships with the Consortium. Eligible candidates must be employed by an institution of higher education in any country except the 27 Member States of the European Union. Selected academics are hosted for a period of minimum of two weeks and maximum of three months in one of the Consortium's institutions. In addition to conducting research in one of the disciplines Mundus MAPP draws on, they are required to teach or develop elements of the Mundus MAPP program (e.g., independently offer or contribute to courses, supervise thesis projects of Mundus MAPP students, participate in Mundus MAPP study visits). After ending their visiting scholar activities, visiting scholars are expected to contribute to the promotion and dissemination of the Erasmus Mundus Programme in general, and Mundus MAPP in particular, in their higher education institution and country of origin.

Interested academics are invited to elaborate on their proposed contribution to Mundus MAPP in their application form. The exact form of contribution is determined by a contract between the visiting scholar and the Mundus MAPP Consortium.

The European Commission supports academics contributing to Mundus MAPP by special scholarships under the Erasmus Mundus Programme. The Consortium selects, and forwards a list of scholars to be supported each year to the European Commission for approval.

Academic visits may start as early as September 2013 and continue during the 2013-2014 academic year, but should take place during teaching terms.

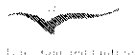

MUNDUS MAPP

The Erasmus Mundus Masters Program in Public Policy (Mundus MAPP), launched in 2007, is a 2-year-long international Masters program funded by the European Commission. The program has been granted financial support for an additional 5 cycles starting in 2012 by the European Commission, and for the new scheme has introduced a new, integrated curriculum.

Four leading European universities joined forces to deliver Mundus MAPP: Central European University in Budapest (Hungary), Institut Barcelona d'Estudis Internacionals (Spain), the International Institute of Social Studies of Erasmus University in the Hague (Netherlands), and the University of York (UK).

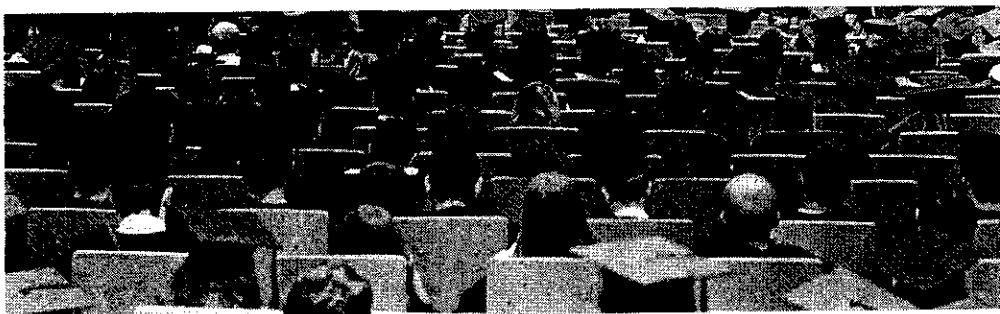
Building on Mundus MAPP's successful track record, the integrated curriculum provides a uniform core of policy studies as well as modules specific to particular mobility tracks, drawn predominantly from the fields of International Relations, European Studies and Development Studies. The four mobility tracks allow students to specialize in Political Economy and Development, Governance and Development, and European and Global Public Policy, respectively. Each mobility track includes a field trip to relevant public sector organizations and an internship.

The European Commission's Erasmus Mundus program provides scholarships to outstanding students from within and outside the European Union to attend Mundus MAPP. The Consortium universities also support these students by offering partial tuition fee waivers to Erasmus Mundus scholarship recipients.

Application deadlines:

January 3, 2013: For applicants who seek and are eligible for Erasmus Mundus scholarships. Applications must be submitted complete with proofs of English proficiency and recommendation letters.

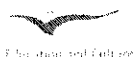
May 6, 2013: For applicants who do not wish to be considered for financial aid.
