Dear Madam,

With reference to the letter cited above we are pleased to acknowledge the receipt of the report. The University has been conceptualized by a philanthropist trust which has established a socio-spiritual organization named as Shantikunj dedicated to 'man-making' through thought transformation based on plethora of literature generated and developed by its founder Pandit Sri Ram Sharma Acharya. The university is an extension to carry forward this ideology by adopting healthy, sensitive and value based system of education. We are happy to find our ideology being reflected through the observations made by the august members of the committee.

However, few suggestions have been indicated which we respect and consider useful for better functioning of the university. Please find below the action taken report on the suggestions:

Suggestions by the Committee	Action taken by the university
University should create a separate Examination wing headed by Controller of Examination or Registrar (Evaluation).	University has already created a separate Examination cell vide its notification 58/त. नि./2010, dated 3/11/2010. Accordingly Dr. Chinmay Pandya, the Director, School of Yoga & Health has been given full charge to look after this cell. The semester end examination is being conducted by the cell. Evaluation of answer sheet and declaration of result will be managed by this cell. In addition, the entrance examination for certificate course

	scheduled on 26 th December, 2010 will also be conducted by this cell. In this process, the cell is fully operational. (Annexure-1)
The course should be updated/reviewed from time to time	The university has been updating and reviewing the courses which are evident from the record of meetings Board of Studies and Academic Council. Moreover, instructions have been issued to all the Directors & HOD's to review the curriculum and revise appropriately from time to time. (Annexure-2)
All Four Faculties of the university should have specific departments/schools and each department/school have specific subjects/courses with provision for introducing interdisciplinary course/s.	Out of the 4 faculties, the university has established schools relating to 2 faculties i.e. School of Yoga & Health & School of Education. School of Spiritual Sciences is being created. For the fourth faculty i.e. Swavlamban, the Department of Rural Development & Entrepreneurship is already in operation. The provision for interdisciplinary courses are included in the School of Yoga & Health by combining Yoga with Psychology, Yoga with Management, Psychology with Aurveda etc. (Annexure-3)
Special arrangements should be made for teaching of Sanskrit, English and other Indian Language wherever it is essential.	The university already has the Department of English & the Department of Sanskrit. Both these languages are included at graduate level courses and additional inputs of these languages are provided to Masters Degree Student as optional.
Special arrangements should be made for deputing the faculty or organizing Refresher Course/Orientation Programme for newly appointed teachers.	The faculties of different departments are being sent regularly for attending refresher courses organized by various universities. The university also organizes orientation programmes from time to time. (Annexure-4)
Sports activities need more encouragement in the light of rising national competition levels.	Besides the existing facilities for games and sports like basket ball, badminton court, football and cricket ground etc. the university is planning to create more facilities. The students are encouraged to participate in games and sports as part of

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	in-house competition. Efforts are made to provide coaching facilities and motivate the students to participate in inter-university, State, National and International competition.
University should organize Workshops/Seminars and Conferences to constantly expose the students and scholars in respective subjects and also to update in the concerned subject to raise their academic level.	The list of workshop/seminars organized by the university was already placed on record before inspection. After inspection the university has organized three Seminars/Workshops. Therefore, the continued efforts towards this direction are being made. (Annexure-5)
Periodical/Research Journal of university needs to be started.	The university has already started 'Dev Sanskriti', a research journal in the year 2003 (Registration No: UTTBIL/2003/11514) which is continuing. A journal dedicated to Yogic Sciences has also been planned. A student magazine is published annually besides e-journals containing views of students. (Annexure-6)
UGC may be approached to start NET in new courses run by the university.	UGC is being approached to plan and start NET in the area of Yogic Science.
University must undertake academic publications in the new/novel courses initiated by it.	The university has already planned for academic publications in the areas of Yogic Science, Water and River Management and Jyotish Piyush. It is expected that the publications will be available by the end of 2011. Publication of Ph.D thesis of different departments is already under progress.
The Committee find the potentiality of the university to develop as Centre of Excellence in Yoga.	Keeping in view the course curriculum and the students performance, State and National Level competitions and periodic camps being organized by the university in the premises and outside the premises. The Ministry of Health, Govt. of India through Morarji Desai Institute of Yogic Science (A National Institute) has already identified the university as the Nodal Agency to organize specialized kind of training programmes for teachers of Uttarakhand,

	<p>Uttar Pradesh, Jharkhand and Bihar. The university has also been identified as the Nodal Centre to establish and monitor District Yoga Wellness Centre in the State of Uttarakhand, UP and Bihar. Besides this the university is identified as the training centre for providing modular training programme to practicing doctors of Uttar Pradesh and Uttarakhand. Interest shown by foreign students/tourists and their participation in Master Degree programme and modular programmes in the field of Yogic Science shows the quality and standard of the university. It is worth mentioning that groups from Italy, Russia, Indonesia and Argentina have already been trained by the university. The university has signed MOU with other universities of China, Russia, Italy and Indonesia, Argentina for establishing centre of yogic sciences, conducting research and faculty development programmes. (Annexure-7)</p> <p>Based on the observations of the visiting team of UGC, the university proposes to apply to AYUSH, Govt. of India for becoming Centre of Excellence in the field of Yogic Sciences.</p> <p>In the process, the university is moving towards excellence in the field of Yogic Science.</p>
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Concluding, we assure you that the university will keep on making continued efforts in these directions.




