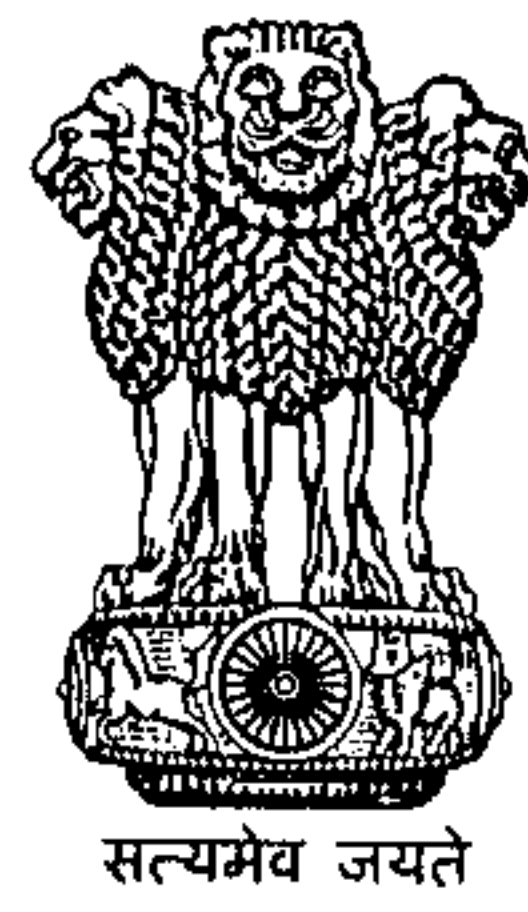

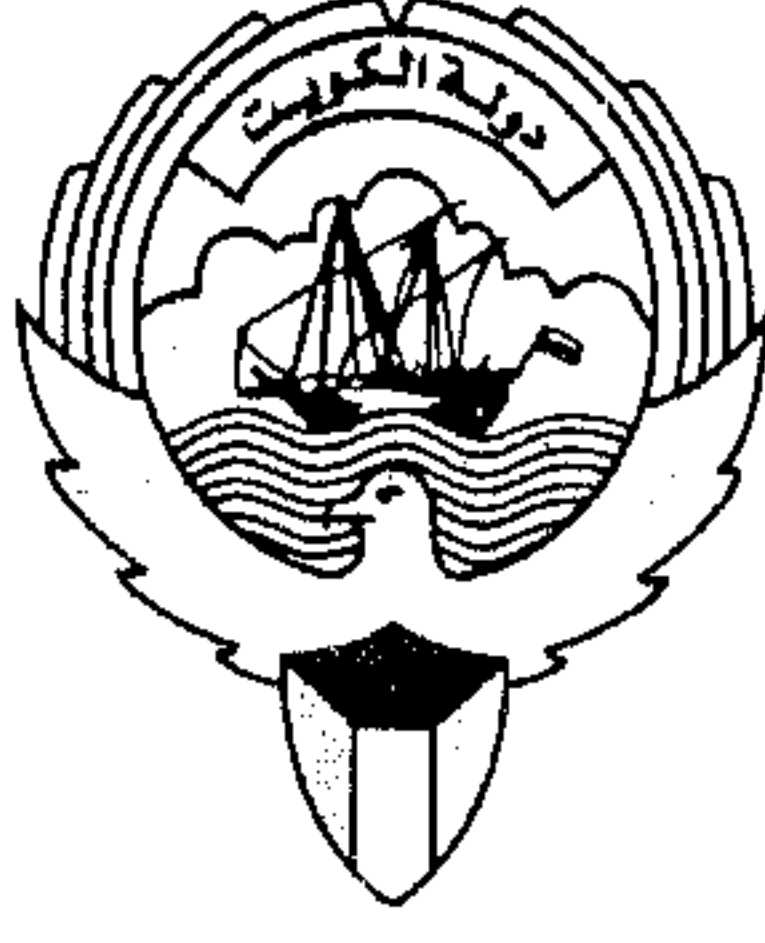

**Conditions for Cultural Scholarship of Kuwait
University 2014/2015**

1. Percentage of Senior Secondary for holder of Saudi certificate will be calculated as per the system used by Kingdom of Saudi Arabia for the students to undergo an aptitude test and entrance test conducted by the National Assessment and evaluation Center of the Ministry of higher-education of Kingdom of Saudi Arabia (Average calculation method attached).
2. Admission in all colleges (Except College of Science) will be based on merits as per the decision of the University Council on 19/03/2014 which will be calculated according to the percentage specified in the attached schedule and the admission of the candidate is subjected to his qualification of merit required for the college applied for after his performance in the eligibility test. A student registered with a specified college will not be allowed to transfer to other college, except in the case when a vacancy of his country available in the college to which he is interested to transfer.
3. The name of Girls College has been changed life science and girls/ boys students who passed senior secondary can enroll themselves.
4. One applicant will be accepted as per the distribution of seats specified for each country and in case of not meeting the admission terms of the college or failure to achieve the required percentage for admission in the college, nomination of the student will be cancelled.
5. The student can re apply for admission, if there is vacancy in the college as the candidate can also apply for other college if he could not achieve the required percentage, provided there is vacancy in the college.

6. The candidate should fulfill other conditions, college may specify for its students.

7. Percentage in the Senior Secondary should not be less than 75% (2.75) in Science, 80% (3 points) in literature.

8. There should not be gap for more than four academic session or two academic years.

9. Equivalency of Senior secondary certificate (attained from out of Kuwait or private schools in Kuwait) from Private education department of the Ministry of Education-Kuwait.

***Remark:-**

Deanship of Students' affairs presents to the Deanship of Admissions and registrations a list of the number of cultural grants of Kuwait University to friendly and brotherly countries and after the admission of the student , he must register himself and study in the class in which he has been registered, otherwise his admission will be cancelled, if he is not submitting a request to delay his joining from the next academic session during an specified period as per the university calendar, otherwise, the grant will be cancelled for the sector or the country which submitted the nomination for him and it can not nominate other student in palce of him to take advantage of the grant in the next academic session, except when it submits a request to withdraw the documents of this student from the university during the firs six weeks in the beginning of the session.

***Document required:-**

- 1. Original application for admission.
- 2. Certificates

- From inside the State of Kuwait : Original Senior Secondary certificate or copy.
- From outside of Kuwait: a copy of senior secondary certificate + original for verification.

3. Certificate of Senior Secondary equivalency from Private Education Department of the Ministry of Education for the certificates attained from out of Kuwait or Private Schools in Kuwait.

4. Copy of the civil ID or Passport.

5. Photograph (2 Nos.)

6. Nomination letter from Deanship of Students' Affairs (Incomplete admission forms or not meeting the terms and conditions of Admission will be rejected and returned to Deanship of students' affairs.)

Terms and method of calculating average for Senior Secondary students in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia

1. The Student appears in aptitude test more than once during last two years of Senior Secondary.
2. The student appears scientific achievement test once in a year.
3. The highest mark is taken of the aptitude tests.
4. Aptitude and achievement tests are valid for two academic years.
5. Marks of non academic courses, behavior and attendance are removed while calculating percentage of Senior Secondary.

*. Method of calculating average of Science : $30\% \times$ average of senior Secondary) $+30\% \times$ Aptitude test) $+ 40\% \times$ achievement test).

*. Method of calculating average of Literature: (60% x average of Secondary High School + (40% x Aptitude test).

*Academic eligibility exams required for every college and percentage specified
for it*

The following schedule describes the exams required for each college and percentage specified for its calculation under the merit required for competition for the seats of different colleges.

Mark (*) means the exam is to specify level only and will not be considered for merit.

The base of admission in all colleges of the university is merit calculated according to the results of academic eligibility exams with the percentage of High School, except Science College, after the student qualifies all minimum conditions for the admission in the University, unless the college requires a higher percentage or specified merit.

The admission in all colleges (except College of Science) will be on merit basis which will be calculated as per the percentage specified in the attached schedule. The admission of the student is subjected to qualification of merit specified for the college applied for after conducting eligibility test. Student registered with a college will not be allowed to transfer to other college except in case there is seat available in the quota of his/her country.
