(ii)	Weaknesses of the University	• Hostel facilities for students particularly the girls is non existent. • There is no extension counter of any Bank and post office. • Most of the faculty members are at Assistant professor level without Ph. D. Only 4 faculty members have Ph. D. degree. • Cadre ratio in the faculty is highly unsatisfactory. There is lack of faculty at Professor and Associate professor level required to mentor the younger faculty. • There is no research programme leading to Ph. D. degree.

A. General Observations and suggestion

The university is very young and in its evolutionary phase. The sponsors appear to have adequate financial and physical infrastructure resources to sustain the functioning of the university. The sponsors, teaching and non-teaching staff and the students show strong commitment to the cause of the university. Specific suggestions are as follows: (i) The approach road from the main road of the city to the university entrance need to be repaired at the earliest,

(ii) the construction of a girl's hostel should be the priority. (iii) special efforts ought to be made to induct senior level faculty and (iv) academic programmes at doctorate level should be initiated at the earliest.
