This global observance not only pays tribute to these lifesaving individuals but also serves as a strong call to action, highlighting the ongoing need for voluntary and unpaid blood donations to ensure a safe and adequate blood supply for everyone.

World Blood Donor Day 2026 will be commemorated with the theme: "One Drop of Humanity. Give Blood. Save Lives". The objectives of this year's campaign are:

1. Drive sustained growth in regular, voluntary, unpaid blood donation worldwide, supporting equitable access to safe blood and resilient health systems.
2. Raise awareness of the critical need for blood and plasma donations and their life-saving impact, while inspiring a new generation of donors.
3. Highlight the vital contribution of blood donors to health and well-being, and promote the values of solidarity, humanity, and collective responsibility.
4. Mobilize governments and development partners to invest in and sustain national blood programmes, with a view to achieving universal access to safe blood transfusion.

In this regard, all Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) are requested to organize suitable programs to mark the observance of World Blood Donor. These may include awareness activities, voluntary blood donation camps, and other outreach efforts. HEIs are also encouraged to actively disseminate the campaign messages through various platforms, including social media, print, and electronic media. etc. to promote community engagement and participation.

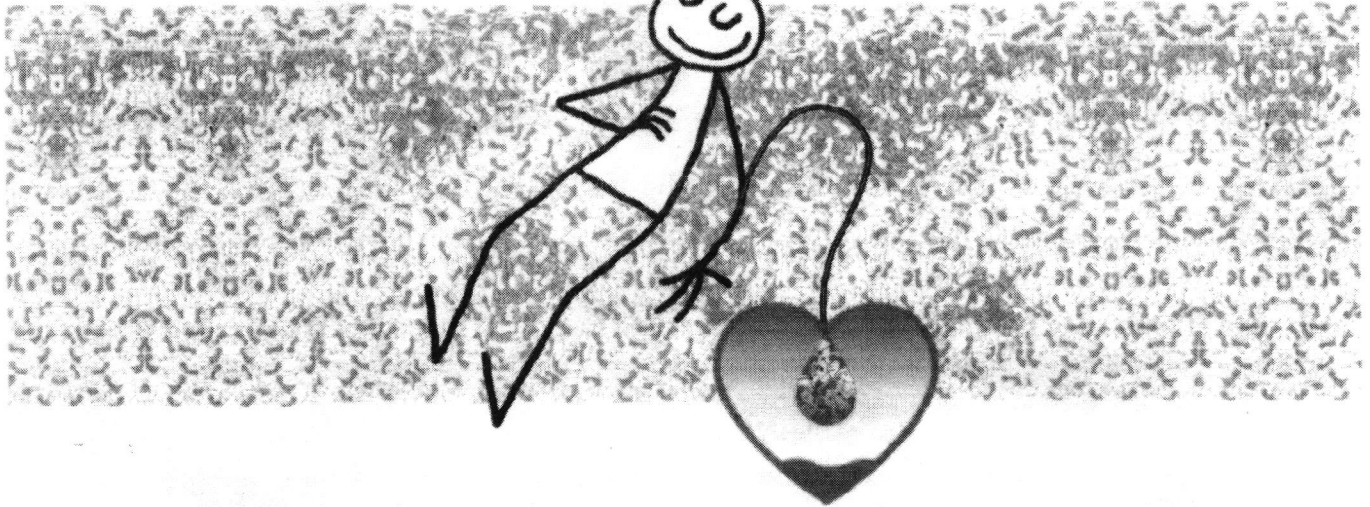
